Begbies Traynor Group doubles its Edinburgh city centre office space



Leading business rescue and recovery specialist Begbies Traynor Group has moved its growing team to larger offices in the centre of Edinburgh's financial district.

The firm has signed a five year lease for 3,263 sq ft of Grade A office space in Edinburgh Quay, Fountainbridge. As well as giving the team almost twice as much space as its former offices in Canning Street, the modern offices also feature large meeting rooms and provide a more convenient and prestigious environment for clients.

The Group has been looking for larger, city centre offices to house its expanding teams of Edinburgh-based corporate and personal insolvency, restructuring, property and forensics experts. Its staff in the city has doubled over the last three years from 10 to 20 due to the organic growth of its spread of financial services together with the acquisition of a smaller firm.

"Not only are our new offices in a fantastic location in the heart of Edinburgh's financial district, the Grade A office space reflects the continuing success of the Edinburgh practice and also provides the additional room we will need for further expansion over the next three to five years," explains Paul Dounis, partner at the Group's Edinburgh office. "This latest investment is another demonstration that while other insolvency firms are contracting, Begbies Traynor Group is continuing to grow and offering enhanced services to an expanding client base."

The new office was sourced by the Group's in-house chartered surveyor Paul Aylmer who also assisted with the negotiation of the lease terms and fit-out. Paul is part of a team which provides specialist advice on all of the firm's property-related insolvency cases in Scotland.
