Former Southport post office to be auctioned



Southport's former post office, which closed in 2016, is to go up for sale at Pugh's next North West property auction, at the AJ Bell Stadium in Manchester on 4 June.

The 5,000 s ft 19th century property on Lord Street has been given a guide price of £195,000

Paul Thompson, managing director of auction house Pugh, said: "This is a handsome and historic building in the heart of the town and there is enormous potential for redevelopment, subject to the buyers obtaining the relevant planning consent.

He added: "As post office and banks close across the country many unique, interesting and sometimes historic properties, such as this one, are coming on to the market with lots of possibilities for new and imaginative future uses."

Established 26 years ago, Pugh is the largest auctioneer outside of London and was acquired by property consultant Eddisons in 2016. The firm's next property auctions, featuring more than 100 properties and plots of land, will take place at the AJ Bell Stadium in Manchester on 4 June and at Leeds United's Elland Road football ground in Leeds on 6 June.
